

WASBA CLUB OF THE YEAR POINTS CHECKLIST

The Washington State Beekeepers Association is happy to support the Large and Small Bee Club of the Year competition. The competition will go from September 1 of the previous year to August 31 of the current year. The following checklist must be submitted NLT 5 September of the current year.

The winning clubs will receive the following:

Large Club of the year – A plaque and a cash prize of \$750

Small Club of the Year – A plaque and a cash prize of \$500

To be eligible, the club must be a WASBA member

Required Events (3 of 6 must be completed to be eligible for Club of the Year)

- Host a booth at a WASBA event.
- Donate an auction item for the annual conference as a club.
- Submit and have published an article in the WASBA Newsletter.
- Have two or more club members serve on a WASBA committee.
- Have a club swarm response team that responds to swarm calls from the WASBA website.
- Have a Club Liaison whose primary duty is to work with WASBA's Club Liaison

EVENT SIGN IN SHEET (page 4) each event must be submitted to WASBA with the checklist NLT 5 Sept.
